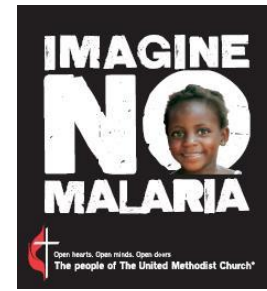

**People: So we will join others in a common fight against malaria.**

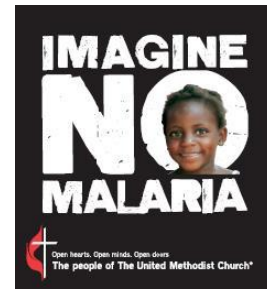
Leader: Together we will eliminate this dreaded killer of children and pregnant women.

## OFFERTORY PRAYERS

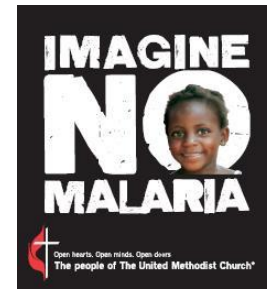

However, the good news is you have given us an opportunity, through the Imagine No Malaria, to strike a blow against fear and to emulate your extravagant generosity through our actions.

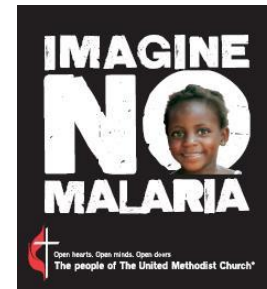
Help us move beyond our tendency to see only the headlines of doom and gloom and risk extravagant care for others that the world might be healed, that the world might be saved. Amen.
