CUIC created the “CUIC Institute on Ecumenism;” a young adult cohort, in order to help train persons within the United States in the Ecumenical and Interreligious Movements. Participants will be trained in the history and theology of the Ecumenical Movement, the history and theology of the Interreligious Movement, current trends in both, and the particular connections among the CUIC Member Communion.

The cohort will represent the 10 CUIC Member Communion and may be lay or clergy. The age range for young adults includes anyone around 40 and younger. Those chosen must be able to commit to 10 months of training, be able to travel to two three-day, in-person gatherings in the United States, have access to a phone and internet, and be willing to organize and lead a ministry project in their home context. Those chosen to participate in this special training agree to each of those requirements and agree for their name and image to be used in articles and advertisements of CUIC.
